CiDial is a software application that allows you to easily dial-up online via a dial-up connection. It supports many dial-up servers (most of which are not included). In the Preferences window, you can easily set the dial-up settings, such as connection, username and password. CiDial has many useful features, such as: - auto-reconnection when the connection is lost - automatic shrinking of the window when the connection is established - simple status messages - enable/disable auto-reconnection - enable/disable shrink window - portability - no performance overhead And many more... However, there are some minor quirks, which may prove annoying to some, like: - It does not work if you're not connected to the internet at all, so make sure you always have the correct settings before running CiDial - It does not support IPv6 - Only static information is displayed - No history - No support for non-default servers CiDial Review: An easy-to-use program that will allow you to connect to the internet using your dial-up connection. It is a small program with only a few controls, but is very useful and has many benefits. CiDial is a freeware dial-up program for Windows XP, Vista and 7. By scanning the available dial-up servers it will automatically connect you to the one closest to you. It also offers some basic features for managing the connection, such as reconnecting automatically when the connection is lost, and being able to hide the program window. You don't have to have the installation CD for this program, as you can download it directly to your computer. After downloading you will find a.exe file, which you can run on your desktop. You can also download a.zip file that contains the uninstaller for the program, if you want to uninstall it easily later. This file can be run directly on your computer to remove the program from the PC. This is one of the easiest programs I have ever used. It can be easily run from the desktop and the windows control panel, it doesn't have any complicated options or confusing features. This is not an advanced program, but it does have some options that can be controlled by you. You can use the program with any modem and it won't interfere with any other software
